- Verifying gathered information for completeness and accuracy;
- Making corrections and entries in a computer database/system;
- Coding information according to established coding protocols and standards;
- Conducting routine quality control audits of surveys reviewed to ensure validity and accuracy;
- Contacting individuals by telephone to follow up on and correct incomplete/insufficient survey responses;
- Consistently achieving standard expectations of productivity flow rates, accuracy of edits made, and professional conduct in call-back verifications.
